1. Eligibility criteria for admission in B.A./B.Sc (Hons.)

Candidates passing Higher Secondary Examination conducted by West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or any other equivalent board/council (List of the board/councils are listed below) in the year (2020/2021/2022) are eligible to apply for Honours course in **1. Bengali, 2. English, 3. Sociology 4. Geology**, provided that the candidate must have passed in 5(Five)/ 4(Four) (where applicable) recognized subjects including at least one language subject with at least 45% marks in aggregate or 50% marks in subjects or related subjects in the qualifying examination.

2. Eligibility criteria for admission in B.A./B.Sc (General.)

Candidates passing Higher Secondary Examination conducted by West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or any other equivalent Board/Council (List of the Board/Councils are listed below) in the year 2020/2021/2022 are eligible to apply for General course with subjects 1. **Bengali**, 2. **English**, 3. **Sociology**, 4. **History (for B.A. Program)** and 1. **Anthropology**, 2. **Physics**, 3. **Mathematics**, 4. **Zoology**, (For B.Sc Program) provided that the candidate must have passed in 5(Five)/ 4(Four) (where applicable) recognized subjects including at least one language subject.

Candidates passed the Vocational Course can apply in B.A. Program Course only

A CANDIDATE PASSING 10+2 LEVEL BEFORE 2019 WITH ABOVE MENTIONED CRITERIA CAN ALSO APPLY THROUGH ONLINE MODE AFTER GETTING SPECIAL PERMISSION FROM THE SECRETARY, U.G. COUNCIL VIDYASAGAR UNIVERSITY.

Merit Point = X+Y for Honours Course applicants

- X = 10 percent of marks in aggregate in the 10+2 level exam counting the total marks of the **Best of Five Subjects** among the subjects studied excluding the marks of environmental studies / science.
- Y= marks obtained in the applied subject as Hons, If that subject is not studied, consider the marks of one subject as indicated in the table:

Note: If more candidates score same merit point, preference will be given to higher Y, in this way, if more candidates have same merit points and same Y; preference will be given to higher marks in 1st Language.

Merit Point = Z for Pass Course applicants

Z: for the applicants of the General Course, the merit point will be calculated counting the total marks of the **Best of Five Subjects** among the subjects studied excluding the marks of environmental studies / science.
