About the College:

Theme of the Seminar:

Environmental philosophy studies philosophical issues that extend beyond ethical ones, including metaphysical ones concerning the relation of humanity to nature, and that of religious belief to both nature and humanity; aesthetic ones concerning the character of aesthetic value, as found in nature rather than in human art, and its place in education; issues surrounding the interface of environmental ethics. And also issues of political decision-making, and the representation in decision-making forums both of current people and of future and nonhuman interests. Eco-feminists would add the study of parallels between the treatment of nature and of women, and the importance of forms of self-understanding which, instead of privileging the rational, adopt a rounded view of human relationships and identity, with persons recognised as embodied and involved in networks of relationships, both with other people and with other species. Yet others hold that the findings of environmental philosophy can reconfigure our self-understanding as agents, together with our attitudes to our environment and to (the rest of) nature.
